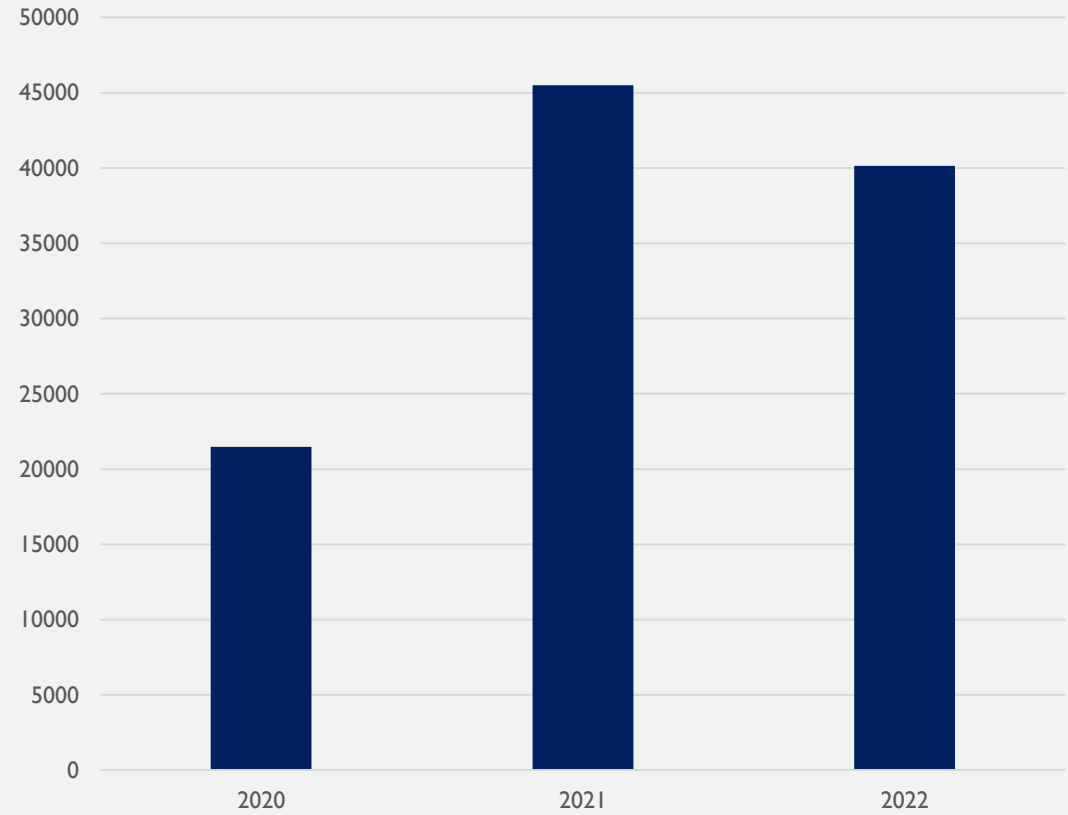

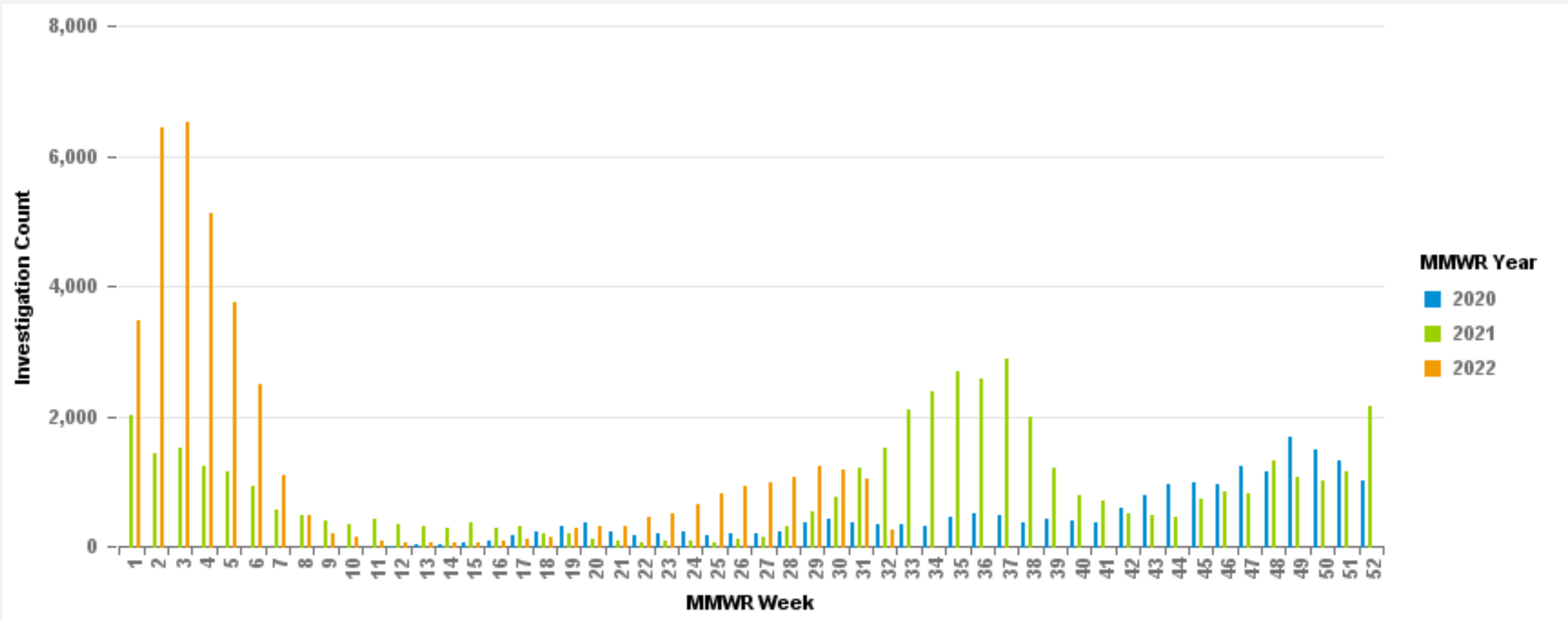

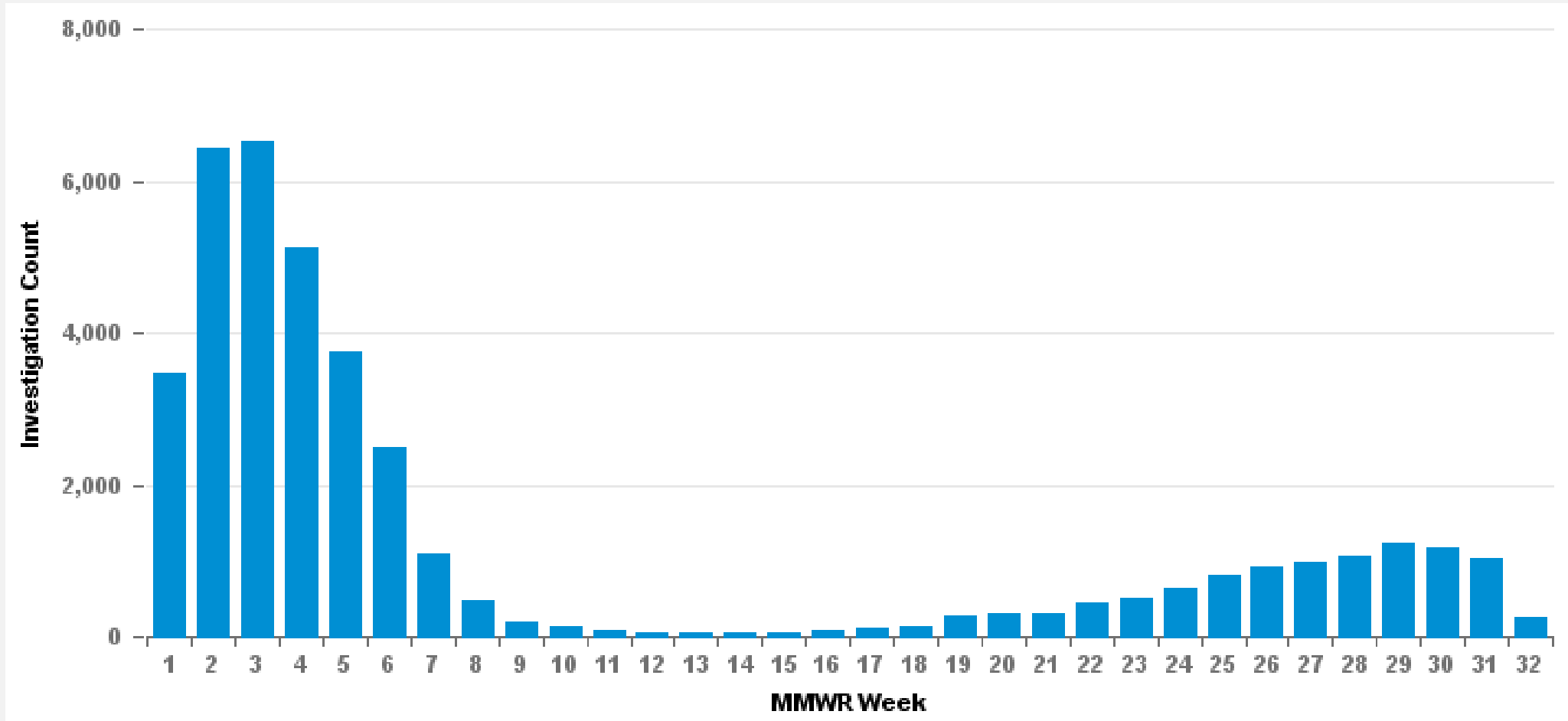
COVID-19 Cases by Year



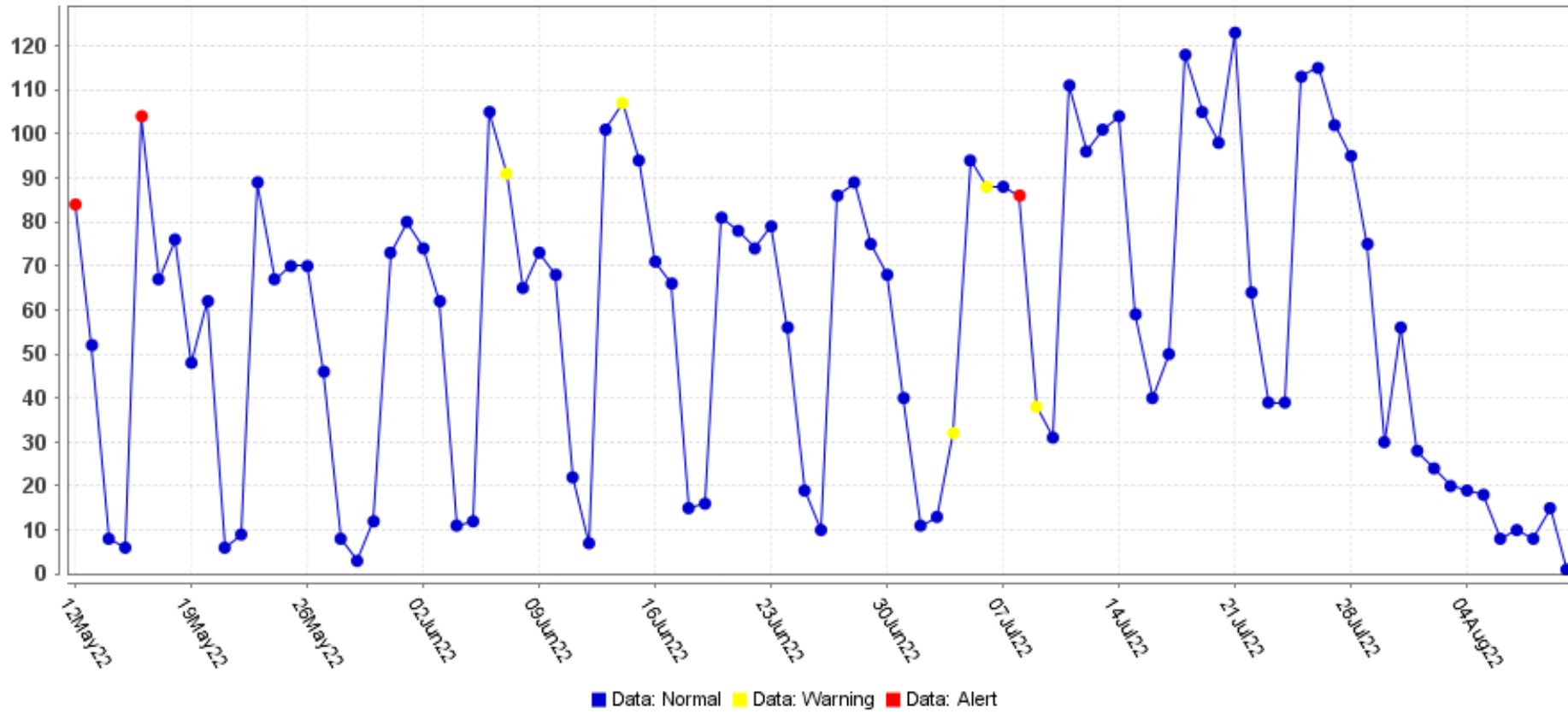
COVID-19 CASES OVERLAY



2022 WEEKLY COVID-19 CASES



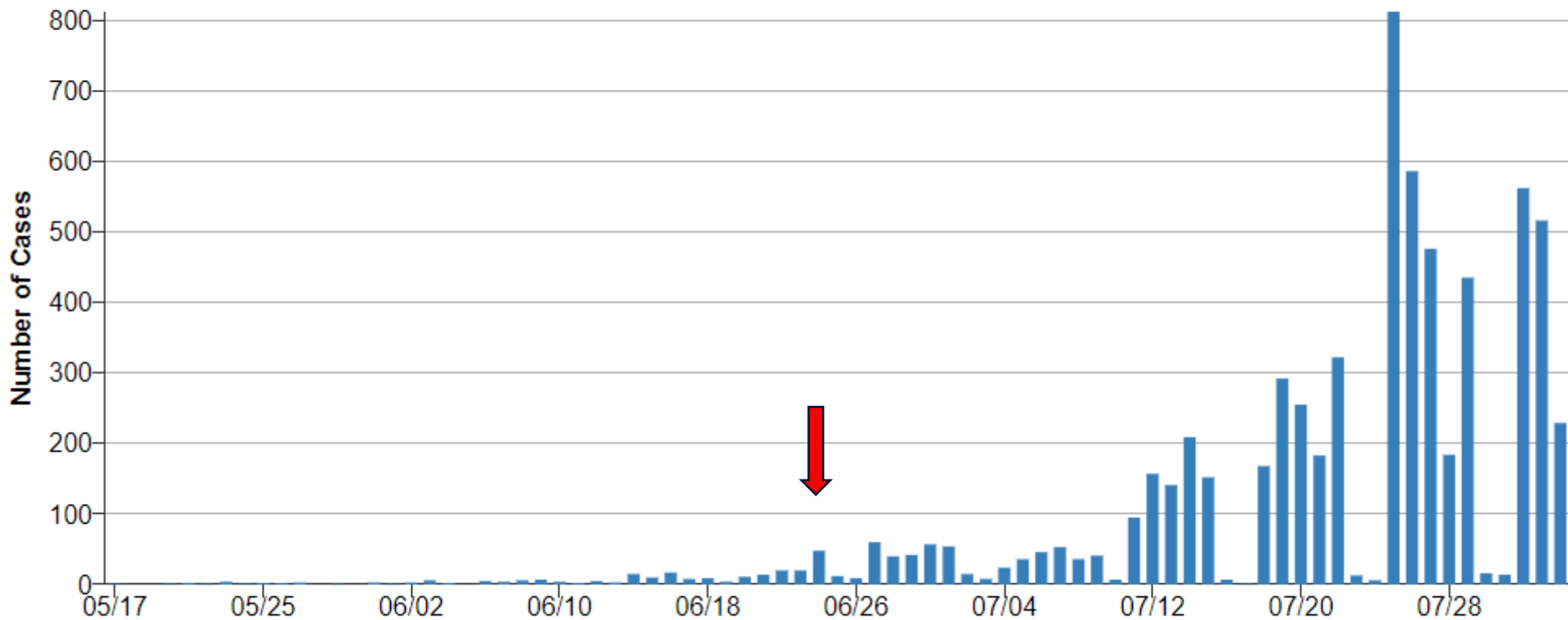

- The drill was sent by TEXT and EMAIL. This exercise served as a required redundant communications drill and the RSVP for this coalition meeting.

Response from All Partners:

83% completed at least one portion of the drill,
up from 82% last month

Response from Core* Partners:

96.9% completed at least one portion of the drill,
up from 90.6% last month

84.4% completed both portions of the drill, up
from 78% last month
